

REMINDERS

We would like every child to have at least 97% attendance.

Please support school by ensuring that your child attends school regularly and that you contact school before 9am if your child is unable to attend. We may visit you at home if we have not received a reason for your child's absence, or if we have concerns about your child's attendance. Please be aware that holidays in term time are not authorized and are likely to result in you receiving a costly fine from the Council. If you do decide to take your child out of school then you must complete a Leave of Absence form from the school office.

We ask that, where possible, any medical appointments for your child are made outside of school hours. Where this is unavoidable, we ask that you bring your child to school before and after their appointment. If you have any queries or difficulties regarding school attendance then please contact Mrs Stringer our Family Support Manager.
