Happy New Year and welcome back to everyone in our school community.

As we begin a new school year, we have lots of exciting plans for the Spring Term. We will be focusing on the outdoor area of the school this term to make improvements to the environment and facilities available to our school community. We will begin work on the Forest School cabin, funded through the National Lottery award, and hope to have the cabin available to provide some Forest School holiday events for Easter and the Summer break.

We are very lucky to be working with Doncaster Council Sustainability Team to develop a Tiny Forest on the school site. Once planted we intend to develop this as a wildlife area for the children to use for bug hunts, den building or a peaceful minute in nature. The Tiny Forest will be equipped with night vision wildlife cameras so our whole school community can see the wildlife that visits the area day and night!

Finally, we are very lucky to have received funding from Doncaster Rotary Club to purchase a greenhouse and garden shed for the allotment area, once this is in place, we will be offering an after-school gardening club for all children to enjoy. We even have plans to enter our homegrown produce into the sustainability competition in the Rotary Club Doncaster Festival this summer, so let's hope for plenty of sunshine for the growing sea-

We are, as always thankful for the support we receive from outside — agencies that make these projects possible for our school community and we look forward to inviting you all to see the finished results.

Also, in 2023, we are delighted to begin our work towards achieving both the Anti-racism Award and the Equalities Award but we need your help.
