<ul> <li>You would like to be kept more informed about your children's learning.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Parent's Evenings increased to three times a year.</li> <li>Parents will be provided with details of their child's latest assessment and current targets at Spring term parents' evening.</li> <li>Links to the school website class pages will be sent out via text. <ul> <li>You would like more after school clubs and a greater variety of actities.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Increased capacity in existing clubs.</li> <li>New clubs offered at the start of Spring Term.</li> </ul>
