




Early Years Newsletter 28th June 2024


In Early Years this week we have been finding out about how people live differently to how we do in Africa. In Reception we have learnt about communities and talked about the different communities we belong to. We also looked at different peoples heritages and that sometimes songs, stories and other traditions are passed down through generations. We have been making observations of fruits and had fun pretending to be Handa and transporting fruit in baskets using our heads. In Nursery we have been focusing on what we can see in stories and making predictions about what might happen next. We printed with different vegetables looking at the different patterns and talking about the textures. Outside we made motorbikes to take us on adventures with the big blocks and have been enjoying using the language shorter and longer while racing boats and cars down the ramps.
