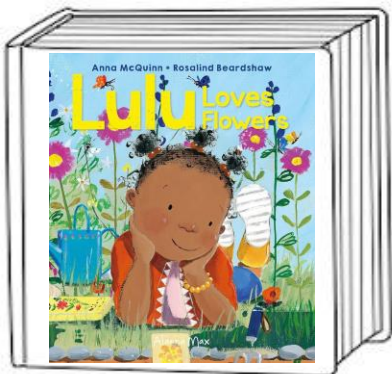


Nursery Newsletter: 17th April 2025.

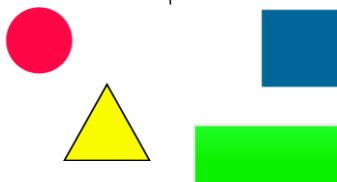
