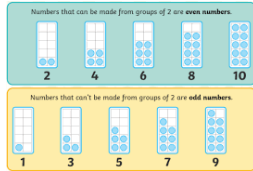

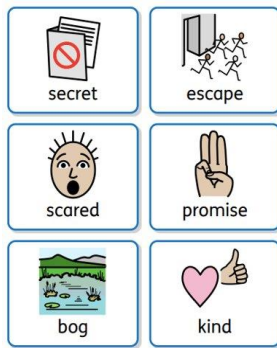

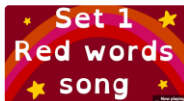

Some activities you could try at home with your child this week:

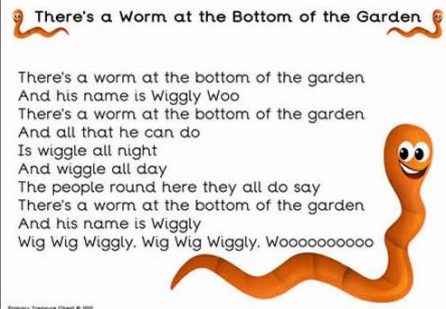
- Walk up and down the stairs and say the odd and even numbers as you do.
