

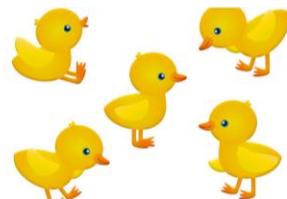
Nursery Newsletter – WC: 2nd June 2025.

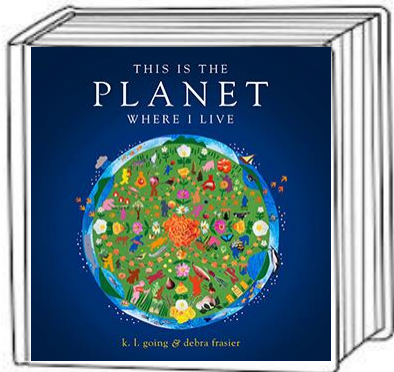
