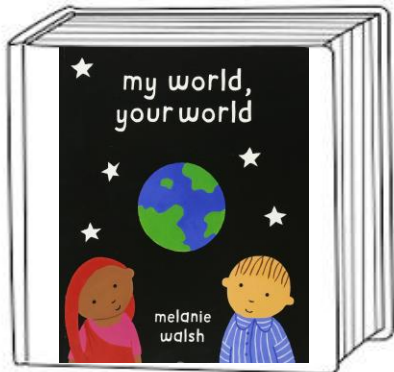


Nursery Newsletter – WC: 16th June 2025.
