Please bring money in a named envelope.



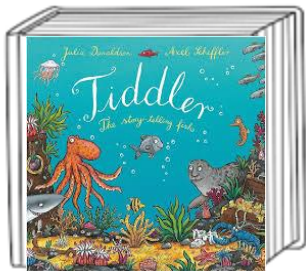
All about number
