Another great, busy week! This week, we have been enjoying reading the story 'Rainbow Fish' by Marcus Pfister. In the story, there is an important message about sharing and how when we share and we are kind, it makes people feel better. In our Creative Area, we have created our own Rainbow Fishes using sparkly paper and coloured tissue paper. In our playdough, using different buttons and dequins, we have created our own fishes. For our Maths learning this week, we have recapped measuring. Each day, we have measured something different. We have measured the height, weight, length of different objects. We have created our own towers and compared whose is taller and whose is shorter. Also, we have used the water to measure – full, half-full and empty.
