This week we would like to put the spotlight on Early Years!

Here at Lakeside, we have an Early Years Unit which was developed in February 2020 and caters for children aged 3-5.

We believe that children learn best through play and with carefully planned provision and activities the children will learn and thrive. One of the most important things as an early year's practitioner is knowing when to intervene in children's play and how to move their learning on.

The provision at Lakeside is continually changing, based on children's interests and observations of how they use the space.

In order to foster a love of books and reading, we base our learning around a book linked to a topic. Our current topic is 'Once Upon a Time' which was launched with a teddy bears picnic where we enjoyed some delicious jam sandwiches and biscuits!

The children have enjoyed books such as 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears' where we enjoyed tasting porridge and acting out the story in the forest and 'Cinderella' where we have made crowns and wands and used them to dance like we are at the ball!

Our children are happy and settled, demonstrate resilience, show great determination and foster a love of learning.



# EARLY YEARS PHONICS

At Lakeside we follow the Read, Write, Inc phonics scheme and this applies to the Early years too!

Once the children are settled in September, we get started with the RWI sessions. The children access two sessions a day initially learning the single letter sounds along with learning to orally blend. The children meet 'Fred' the frog who can only say the sounds in words and needs the children help to say the whole word.

The children are assessed on a regular basis and grouped accordingly.
