If you are familiar with the story already have a go at describing one of the characters. How do they look? What do they wear? What do they say? How do they act? If you are not familiar with the story perhaps pick a character from a story that you are familiar with.</p> <p>Children must continue reading their reading book from school. We also encourage children to read a range of books for extra practise. Oxford Owl provide hundreds of online books, which could be read alongside your school book. The books are tablet friendly and the website is free but you do need to make an account, which is quick and easy to do.</p> <p>Our class text is Charlie and the Chocolate Factory.</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>This week we are going to be setting up an investigation called 'Is it safe to eat'. We will be investigating the 5 second rule by dropping a piece of bread on the floor for 1 second, another for 5 seconds and another for 10 seconds. Finally we will be placing one piece of bread straight into a bag. What do you think will happen to each piece over time? Explain your prediction.</p> <p><u>Geography</u></p> <p>We will be looking at the journey of a banana and completing a piece of writing to explain how the bananas get from Costa Rica to our homes. Use the word mat to help you. Look at the map of the climates in the USA and the different types of farming which takes place in different areas. Can you find any links between the two?
