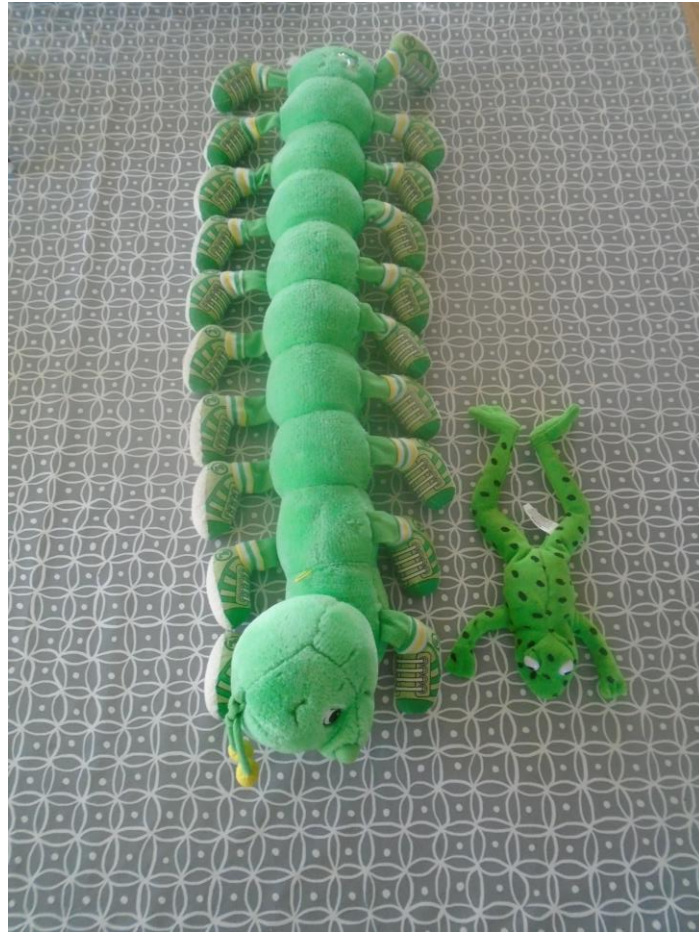


Maths with Colin and Fred

This is what Fred is having!

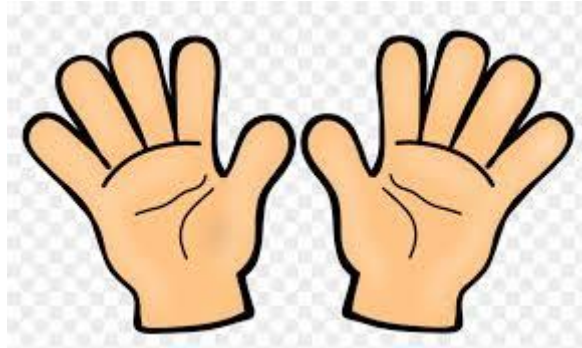
Who has the most?
