

You might find these in recipe books, instruction manuals, in games or other books.</p> <p>Writ instruction about a process that you are familiar with for example... How to make a sandwich or How to build an item. Remember to include a list of equipment needed and a set of instructions.</p> <p>Grammar activity: We are learning about determiners. Look carefully at the poster and then add 'a or an' to the front of each word. E.g. an apple or a car.</p> <p>Reading: Carefully read the text and answer the questions. Remember to find the evidence in the text.</p> <p>Our class text is Stone Age Boy</p>	<p>This week is our topic launch.
