- Recall the story, 'What happened at the end?'
 - Ask, 'Can you read the story to me now?'
- Can you act the story with some teddies, dolls or figures!

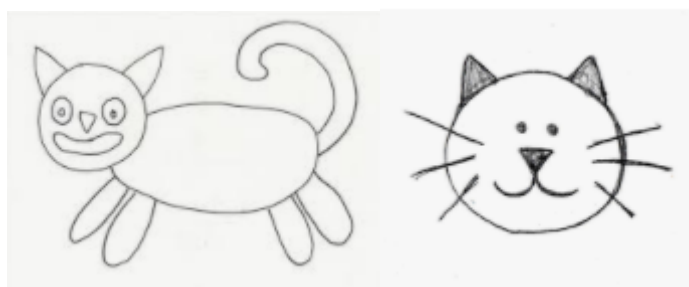
