





<p>Maths</p>  <p>Group 1 and 2: We are going to be looking at time facts. Identifying facts like how many days in each month and months in a year. We can then use this to solve problems. Join our zoom input to help and look at the poem in your pack to help you when needed.</p> <p>Group 3: We are learning about the days of the week and days in the month.</p>	<p>English</p>  <p>For this period of time we will be using a wordless picture book called Chalk as our stimulus. You will have a copy of this book in your pack with each picture numbered so it is easy to refer to.</p> <p>Today you will be exploring pictures from the story and will be making observations, posing questions you want answered and making inferences about what you see.</p>	<p>Handwriting and spelling</p>  <p>Handwriting: We are reviewing the coat hanger family and the up, over stop reverse join.</p> <p>Spelling: Group 1: words ending with <al>, <el>, <il> and Group 2 and 3: Looking for words ending in al and il and complete the word search.</p>	<p>Topic</p>  <p>All groups: Our new topic is Rocks, Relics and Rumbles. Complete the mind map to tell us what you already know about this topic. Then write 5 questions that you would like to find the answers too as we go through the topic. Remember your capital letters and question marks.</p>

Once you have read it complete the vocabulary, summarising, writing questions and predication activities on the sheet.</p> <p>Group 2 and 3: Join us for our zoom session to rehearse the sounds and green words in the book A Hungry Fox.</p> <p>Then read the story out loud. Try to read it more than once and become quicker each time. Add words to describe the fox from the story.</p>	<p>Art</p>  <p>Watch the following video and draw a volcano.
